

Scottish Senior Championships
Scotstoun on Saturday and Sunday 11th & 12th August 2007

The Scottish Senior Championships were held on a drizzly and wet weekend and the fields were dreadfully small for a Scottish Championship.

The first Clydesdale Harrier in action was Junior Ryan Savage who was sixth in his Heat of the 400 meters in 53.2 seconds.

Next up was Derrick Speirs who finished second in his Heat of the 100 metres in 11.31 seconds. In the semi final he clocked 11.34 seconds to be sixth and failed to make the final. On the Sunday he started with 22.96 seconds in his Heat of the 200 metres and then ran 23.09 seconds in the semi final, failing to qualify for the final.

The only other competitor for the Club was Garry Hagan who had just returned from holiday and finished fifth in a very high quality Discus competition against some of the best of English and Irish throwers with a best on the day of 44.91 metres.
